Communication and Language

- Learn and use new vocabulary
- Articulate their ideas and thoughts in well-formed sentences.
- Use talk to help work out problems and to explain how things work and why they might happen.
- Retell the story, once they have developed a deep familiarity with the text, some as exact repetition and some in their own words.
- Engage in non-fiction books.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development

- Show resilience and perseverance in the face of challenge
- Express their feelings and consider the feelings of others
- Identify and moderate their own feelings socially and emotionally.
- Think about the perspectives of others

Physical Development

- Develop their small motor skills so that they can use a range of tools competently, safely and confidently.

- Subitise (recognise quantities without counting) up to 5
- Link the number symbol (numeral) with its cardinal number value.

- Explore the composition of numbers to 10.
- Compare length, weight and capacity.

Literacy

- Read individual letters by saying the sounds for them.
- Blend sounds into words, so that they can read short words made up of known letter-sound correspondences.
- Read a few common exception words matched to the school's phonic programme.
- Read simple phrases and sentences made up of words with known letter—sound correspondences and, where necessary, a few exception words.
- Form lower-case and capital letters correctly.
- Spell words by identifying the sounds and then writing the sound with letter/s.

Understanding the World

- Comment on images of familiar situations in the past
- Recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways
- Explore the natural world around them
- Understand the effect of changing seasons on the natural world around them

Expressive Arts and Design

- Explore, use and refine a variety of artistic effects to express their ideas and feelings.
- Return to and build on their previous learning, refining ideas and developing their ability to represent them.
- Create collaboratively, sharing ideas, resources and skills.

At home:

- Take a journey on public transport, talking about what you can see.
- Encourage your child to talk in full sentences
- Research the Volks Daddy Long Legs with your child. Can you find out anything new? (Brighton Toy Museum and Paradise Park both have models of the Daddy Long Legs if you want to do some fieldwork).
- Encourage your child to write in birthday cards, when sending them to friends.
- Look for numbers in your environement. The number 5 bus. Can you find 5 leaves?
