There is a construction area for building and model making and a role play area that we change to help us imagine all kinds of fun places.



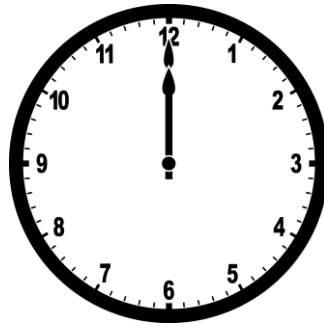
We are very lucky to have lots of outside space to learn and explore.
