Starting School at Rudyard Kipling Primary School & Nursery

We know how important it is that your child's first experiences of school are positive ones. The schedule below is designed to help your child gently settle into school life.

The school day starts with our doors opening at 8.40am for an 8.45am start and finishes at 3.10pm. All Reception children are welcomed in and picked up at the end of the day through Thunberg classroom door (KS1 playground).

On **Thursday 4th, Friday 5th or Monday 8th**, we offer families a 20-minute appointment in school to meet the class teacher; talk about your child and ask any questions you may have. You will be able to collect pre-ordered uniform, bought from our uniform shop on our website, from the office (www.rudyardkiplingprimary.co.uk).

There is no need to confirm this appointment, but if you are unable to make this time please contact the school office as soon as possible and we will do our best to rearrange.


