Headteacher Reports...

Welcome back and a very happy new year to all RKPS families! Indeed, school has been a very happy place to be this week with lorry loads of exciting learning taking place inside and outside of classrooms.

Walking around our school is always exciting: you just never know what learning you are going to bump into. On Wednesday - the first day of term for the children - I saw a Reception child proudly practising writing his name in the frost outside: nature really does enhance learning. After this, I enjoyed seeing a Year I girl being dressed up in full Roman regalia as part of the new Year I Castles topic whilst the other Year I class were performing pikes and other gymnastic feats as part of their PE session. Whilst all this was happening, Year 5 were busy learning all about the various planets and constructing papier mache versions of them using appropriately sized balloons. My walk through the school ended up in Year 6 where the children's brain matter was truly being tested with coordinates challenges which I had to concentrate on to reach an answer: challenge was certainly very present! After school yesterday, our Year 5 and 6 football club re-started with coaches Wynne and Mac most impressed by the performances on the pitches. We are looking forward to our next competitive match when we will be fielding a strong side proud to wear the RKPS colours.
